



FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR SCHOOLS

-  Virtual Journey – Ask a local gym or leisure centre to lend you a few rowing machines or stationary bikes and ask students to form teams OR have student vs teacher teams. Then the challenge is to complete a set distance in a set time e.g. Birmingham to London. Use a Just Giving Page to get sponsorship to complete the challenge. On the day, set up in a central location and use buckets to get extra cash donations. The teams all take it in turns to do their part and the fastest team wins!
-  Dress Down Day – dress up as your favourite character or superhero, glow for it in neon or relax in your PJs!
-  Bake Sale – Get creative in the kitchen and use your culinary skills to turn ingredients into dough for Adoption Focus.
-  Give us a Hand – Donate £1 or £2 and make your mark with a painted handprint mural to make a beautiful, colourful collage of all your classmates.
-  Enterprise Challenge – Students form small teams or ‘companies’ to design and make a product. The school can either pay them a loan or the company has a bake sale for their start-up money. The teams then organise a fair to sell to their fellow students or look for a local market. The profits are donated to the charity Adoption Focus and the ‘company’ that makes the most money wins.
-  Competitions – Colouring competition, short story contest or create your own
-  Raffle – Whether it’s unwanted presents, books, or bric-a-brac, donate your goods and hold a raffle.
-  Music & Dancing – Seasonal concert, disco, panto, host a ‘My School’s Got Talent’ competition or maybe a black-tie dinner? Charge for tickets and refreshments and the profits from your fun-filled nights are donated to Adoption Focus.
-  Sponsored silences – Can the class stay quiet for a full period or an hour?
-  Fashion Show – Along the same lines as music & dancing but with fashion.
